## "Seaside Row" - Month 8



This month, you will piece the middle sky row - the second last row for this quilt!


## You Will Need:

Your very palest plain sky blues, and plain white fabric. We also used a couple of very pale cloud print fabrics. Use several shades of palest plain blue.

## Cut:

This row is made from six, 10 inch blocks. There are 4 Square in a Square blocks, and 2 Drunkard's Path blocks. Refer to the cutting guide and templates at the end, for the pieces you will need for each block.

## Piecing:



As you have done before, we recommend you cut and piece one block at a time, then you can lay out all the pieces first, to work out colour placement as required for each block.

These fabrics in this row of blocks are all randomly placed, but keep the palest blues to the lower half of the block, with the darker mid-blues at the top.


Piece this block in order, starting from the centre.
Join two opposite triangles to each of the corner diamonds and press seams. Then add the remaining two opposite triangles.

Work your way out square by square, pressing seams well as you go.

The blocks should measure $101 / 2$ inches square.
Make 4 all blue blocks.


The final couple of blocks to make are large Drunkard's Path blocks.

Piece the background strips first. From a pale-mid blue, cut two strips measuring $43 / 4$ inches $\times 101 / 2$ inches for the bottom strips.

From a pale blue cut two strips measuring $31 / 2$ inches x $101 / 2$ inches for the middle strips.

From a mid-blue, cut two strips measuring $31 / 4 x$ 1012 inches for the top strips.

Press seams well, then use the template to cut the concave (curve inwards) backgrounds. NOTE one of these blocks is turned, so the white curves form a big semi-circular cloud in the middle, and the strips match up across both backgrounds.

Piece the Drunkard's Path blocks and press seams.

Join the 6 blocks together in a row, with the Drunkard's Path blocks fourth and fifth in the row.

Join Row 8 to Row 7 and press.
Put your quilt top aside for next month.


Next Month, you will make the final row and finish your Seaside Row quilt!
